NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Tønsberg Seilforening, Tønsberg , Norway .

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2001-2004, the rules of the International 2,4 meter Class,(except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions.

The regatta will be classified as a Category C event in accordance with RRS 79 and Regulation 20 (Advertizing Code) of the RRS.

The organizing authority, and the Norwegian Sailing Federation, hereby makes it known to all participants in this event: *By Norwegian law any display of names or pictures of products and/or companies associated with tobacco and/or alcohol is forbidden.*

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

All entrants shall be members of a National Class Association. All competitors shall comply with ISAF Eligibility Rules (RRS , Eligibility Code, Regulation 21).

All entries, together with the Entry Fee shall be made to Tønsberg Seilforening on the enclosed entry form by the closing date for entries. The entry closing date is June 30th, 2001. No entry will be accepted after July, 15th, 2001.

4. FEES

The Entry Fee will be N kr 1200,00 . Later entries than June,30th may be accepted at the discription of the Organizing Authority, at an additional fee of N kr 300,00.

The competitors are responsible for completing registration and measurement within the schedule given here. Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

MEASUREMENT

Measurement in accordance with the class rules will be carried out as per event schedule.

Measurement checks and inspections may be carried out at any time. A boat notified of inspection shall follow the instructions of the Race Committee.

RACING AREA

The racing area will be "Husøyflaket" , north-east of the club location.

RACING COURSES

The format and details of the courses to be sailed will be given in the Sailing Instructions.

SCORING

ISAF appendix A, the Low Scoring system will be used.

JURY

An international jury will be appointed in accordance with Appendix Q. RRS 70.4 will apply.

BUOYANCY

All competitors shall wear, while afloat, personal flotation devices that are in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by a national authority affiliated to the ISAF or a standards organisation, or certification authority, recognized for the purpose by its respective government. Attention is drawn to Fundamental Rule 1.2; this changes rule 40.

PRIZES

The overall winner and the number two and three will be awarded gold, silver and bronze medals. There will be no prize money.

ENTRY DISCLAIMER

It is the competitor's decision to enter the Regatta and to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the Regatta is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entering in the Regatta, competitors shall indemnify the Organizing Authority, its officers, members, servants and agents in respect to all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the Regatta.

The Organizing Authority, its officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the Regatta or howsoever arising in connection with the Regatta.

INSURANCE

All boats/owners shall have third party insurance cover of no less than 1.000.000,00 N. Kr. or the equivalent in any currency, valid for any accident. All owners/competitors who sign the entry form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Owners/competitors who are found not to hold such cover shall have their entry rejected or rescinded.
